5	Used to treat active viral infection		Diflucan / fluconazole
6	Immunosuppression used with or instead of Tacrolimus		Levaquin / levofloxacin
7	Antiviral medication to prevent virus		Lovenox / Enoxaparin sodium
8	Antifungal		Medrol / methylprednisolone
9	Used to prevent/treat gastric reflux		Neupogen / Filgrastim, Granix /tbo-filgrastim
10	Protects liver and gall bladder		Oxy IR /oxycodone
11	Anti-anxiety medication that also helps with nausea		Prilosec / Omeprazole
12	Vitamin supplement		Prograf / Tacrolimus
13	Drops to prevent graft-vs-host disease of eyes		Restasis eye drops / cyclosporine
14	Antibiotic used to prevent/treat infections		Valcyte / valganciclovir
15	Injection used to boost neutrophil count		Vantin / Cefpodoxime
16	Antifungal		Vfend / Voriconazole
17	To treat/prevent nausea		Vitamin D3 / cholecalciferol
18	Short acting pain control		Zofran / Ondansetron
19	Steroid to treat graft-vs-host disease		Zovirax / Acyclovir
