

How to use your Spiriva Respimat

What is my prescription?	Special Instructions
	Take every day to control your symptoms.

What can I expect while I take this medication?

- **Spiriva Respimat** is a long-acting anti-cholinergic that relaxes and opens your airways.
- **Spiriva Respimat** will not provide relief at once, but you can expect to breathe easier.

Your **Spiriva Respimat** will come packaged as two parts, a cartridge and an inhaler. These pieces will need to be put together before you can use it.

- 1. Press the gray safety catch, while pulling off the clear base.
- 2. Take the cartridge out of the box and push the narrow end of the cartridge

into the inhaler.

- 3. The cartridge can be pushed against a hard surface to make sure that it is inserted all the way.
- 4. About 1/8 inch of the cartridge will remain visible when the cartridge is inserted correctly.
- 5. Do not remove the cartridge once it has been inserted into the inhaler.
- 6. Put the clear base back into place.

How and when to prime your Spiriva Respimat:

Prime inhaler if new or has not been used for more than 3 days.

- 1. Hold the inhaler upright with the orange cap closed.
- 2. Turn the clear base in the direction of the white arrows on the label until it clicks.
- 3. Flip the orange cap until it snaps fully open.
- 4. Point the inhaler toward the ground.
- 5. Press the dark gray button.
- 6. Repeat steps 1 to 5 until a spray is visible.
- 7. It will look like a vapor cloud.
- 8. After you see a visible spray; repeat steps 1 to 5 again.

How to use your Spiriva Respimat:

- 1. Hold the inhaler upright with the orange cap closed.
- 2. Turn the clear base in the direction of the white arrows on the label until it clicks.
- 3. Flip the orange cap until it fully snaps open.
- 4. Breathe out fully (in preparation to breathe in medication).
- 5. Close your lips around the end of the mouthpiece without covering the holes on the side of the mouthpiece.
- 6. While taking in a slow, deep breath through your mouth, press the dark gray button and continue to breathe in slowly until your lungs are full.

- 7. Hold your breath for 5-10 seconds, and then breathe out.
- 8. If your physician has prescribed more than one dose (puff), wait 30 seconds and repeat above.
- 9. Put the cap back on.

How to clean your Spiriva Respimat:

Clean the mouthpiece, including the metal part inside the mouthpiece, with a damp cloth or tissue only, at least once a week. Any minor discoloration in the mouthpiece does not affect your Spiriva Respimat inhaler.

Do not use Spiriva Respimat to treat sudden symptoms of your health condition. Always carry a rescue inhaler with you.
