- □ My chest tubes have been removed
- If I had a temporary pacemaker, my pacing wires have been removed
- □ My incision is clean and dry (no new signs of infection)
- □ I do not have a fever
- □ My pain is under control
- □ My nausea is gone or under control
- □ I can urinate without difficulty
- □ I had a bowel movement
- □ I am walking
- I feel like I can return to doing daily activities in the next few weeks
- □ I have a ride home
