The Chelsea Heart Failure Program is designed for people with heart failure requiring a hospital stay. This program is directed by Michigan Medicine heart failure specialists and begins with inpatient care at St. Joseph Mercy Chelsea Hospital.

#### What you can expect before admission:

- If you are eligible, our team can arrange for you to be admitted directly to your hospital room at St. Joe's Chelsea so you can avoid the Michigan Medicine Emergency Department.
- We provide transportation to and from St. Joe's Chelsea at no cost to you.

## What you can expect in the hospital:

- Michigan Medicine doctors and heart failure specialists provide expert care.
- Communication with your primary care doctor and heart doctor.
- Visits with heart failure doctors, nutritionists, and pharmacists.
- In most cases, private rooms are available in the relaxing environment of Chelsea, MI (15 minutes from Ann Arbor)!

## What you can expect after discharge:

- Two visits with the Michigan Medicine Heart Failure Team the first 2 weeks after discharge.
  - These can be virtual or in-person at the CVC or a local clinic. If you are not comfortable with virtual visits, we can arrange a phone visit.
- Access to written and virtual education materials to learn about your disease.
- Our heart failure nurses will monitor your health after discharge and are available if you develop symptoms or need assistance with medications, labs, or anything else.
