

## Outpatient Breastfeeding Clinics (Michigan Medicine)

---

Michigan Medicine offers outpatient lactation clinic support to mothers and infants with breastfeeding concerns including but not limited to:

- Latch difficulty
- Inadequate weight gain/failure to thrive
- History of breast surgery
- Mastitis /Breast Pain
- Nipple pain
- Inverted nipples
- Low milk supply

Each breastfeeding clinic is staffed by an International Board Certified Lactation Consultant (IBCLC). Some of the clinics are also staffed by an OB/GYN doctor who specializes in breastfeeding concerns. Many insurance plans provide coverage for lactation services. Please contact your insurance company to verify coverage. Your primary care provider (PCP) may refer you to the clinic, but a doctor referral is not required.
