



How to Use ENFit Supplies: For Pump, Gravity or Syringe


How do I give a pump or gravity feeding?

1. Before you start a feeding, remove the white plastic (transition) piece from the end of the pump or gravity bag set by twisting it off (Figure 1).



- 2. Prime formula from the feeding bag to the end of the gravity or pump bag. Stop formula before it reaches the end of the tubing.
- 3. Before starting the feeding, twist together the end of the gravity or pump bag to the end of your ENFit feeding tube or ENFit extension set (Figure 2 & 3).






- 4. Open extension set clamp; start the feeding until done.
- 5. Close the clamp on the extension set before removing the end of the gravity or pump bag so the formula does not leak.

How do I use the ENFit syringe to flush the tube?

- 1. Fill an ENFit syringe with water.
- 2. Twist off the end cap of the feeding tube or extension set and twist the syringe into the end for a tight fit (Figure 4).
- 3. Open the extension set clamp and flush with water.
- 4. Close the end of the extension set or feeding tube by twisting on the end cap.

Note: Oral and Catheter tip syringes cannot be used with an ENFit tube or ENFit extension set



How do I give a Syringe feeding by using an ENFit Syringe?

- 1. Fill an ENFit syringe with formula (Figure 5).
- 2. Twist the ENFit syringe into the end of the ENFit extension set or feeding tube.

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- 3. Open the extension set clamp.
- 4. Push in the formula with the syringe until the feeding is done (Figure 6).



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
