

Cleaning My TE Voice Prosthesis in Place What Do I Do?

Sit or stand in front of a mirror (magnified if you have one) with a good light source

- 1. If there is an insertion strap on the TE voice prosthesis, hold it down to your neck to secure in place.
- 2. Insert the cleaning brush into the center of the voice prosthesis.
- 3. Slowly rotate the brush clockwise for 2 complete rotations.
- 4. Rotate the cleaning brush counter-clockwise for 2 complete rotations. On the second rotation, slowly begin to remove the brush from the prosthesis (Twist it in a motion similar to what you would do to remove a screw then gently pull the brush out while twisting it).
- 5. Fill the pipet or flush with saline.
- 6. Place the pipet/flush into the center of the TE voice prosthesis and squeeze, flushing the liquid through the TE voice prosthesis. Leave the pipet/flush in place until the "bulb" refills with air.
- 7. Repeat steps 2-6 as needed.
- 8. Clean the voice prosthesis 2-3 times per day or as needed.
- 9. After use, store pipet or flush face down to allow excess liquid to drain from the "bulb".
- 10. After each use, clean the brush in a solution of 50% peroxide and 50% water. Allow to air dry on a flat surface, or place in a container with the bristles upright. **Do not** place brush in a closed container following use.

*****Do not** use the cleaning brush to remove secretions from the trachea or front of the voice prosthesis***
