Sudden Onset Leaking Through Voice Prosthesis or The Valve Is Stuck Open What Do I Do?

- 1. Place a cotton-tipped applicator or a Q-tip in the end of the voice prosthesis to plug the shaft. This will prevent the fluids from coming through the voice prosthesis.
- 2. Drink 8-12 ounces of a warm beverage (i.e. coffee or tea) or a carbonated drink (i.e. Coke or Pepsi).
- 3. Remove cotton tipped applicator.
- 4. Clean the voice prosthesis with the cleaning brush.
- 5. Flush warm water or saline through the prosthesis with a pipet or flush.
- 6. Produce a loud "aaahhhhhhh" -as if yelling at somebody.
- 7. Take a drink and monitor for leaking through the voice prosthesis. If there is still leaking, repeat steps 1-7.
- 8. If leaking continues after you have gone through this process 3-4 times, contact your Speech-Language Pathologist.
