

Alternating Leg Taps (Abs)





- 1. Lie flat on your back, with both your legs fully extended.
- 2. Lift your upper body **slightly** off the ground.
- 3. Keep your **arms straight at your sides**. Then reach down your leg on one side by sliding your palm down the side of your leg. Switch and reach down the other side.
- 4. Alternate reaching from side to side.

Repeat for ___ repetitions and ___ total sets.
