What can Patient Financial Counseling help me with?

Health coverage

We can help determine your eligibility, application and enrollment for Michigan Medicaid, Children's Special Health Care Services and marketplace plans.

Billing and insurance

We can assist you with determining health care coverage, out of pocket costs, and find out if Michigan Medicine has a contract with your insurance plan. Our patient financial counselors act as a liaison between Michigan Medicine and your insurance company to resolve billing issues.

Price transparency

We want to help you determine what your out-of-pocket cost is going to be so that you can make informed choices about your healthcare.

Payment arrangements

Whether you are uninsured or insured, we can explore financial options that may be available to you.

Financial assistance

Our policy supports medically necessary healthcare for all people, regardless of their ability to pay. MSupport is our financial assistance program that may help you if you are uninsured or have limited or exhausted insurance benefits.
