Oxycodone (Opioid pain medication)	Every 4-6 hours if needed	Pain control	sleepiness, constipation				
Acetaminophen (Tylenol®)	Every 4-6 hours if needed	Pain control					
Docusate ( Colace®) 20 lb = 2.5ml 30 lb = 4 ml	Daily	Prevent constipation	diarrhea				
polyethylene glycol 3350 (Miralax)®	Daily	Prevent constipation	diarrhea				
Oxybutynin (Ditropan®)	Every 6 to 8 hours	Prevents bladder spasms	red face, constipation				
Sulfamethoxazole /trimethoprim (Bactrim®) (antibiotic)	Once a day	Prevents infection	rash, gi upset				
Antibiotic ointment or petroleum jelly (Vaseline)	With each diaper change	Prevents infection. Prevents incision from sticking to the diaper	rash				
Ibuprofen (Motrin® or Advil®) (Do not give to children under 6 months of age)	Every 6-8 hours	Pain control and decrease bladder spasms	stomach ache
