

# Cancer Patient Checklist for Oral Surgery

# What do I need to do before I can have oral surgery?

We have put together a checklist of things you will need to complete before you have oral surgery. One of our nurses will work through this with you. Use the checkboxes and information below to help you understand what has been recommended, and what must be completed, before you have surgery.

#### Lab work

You can complete your labs at any of the Michigan Medicine drawing stations listed later on in this handout. You do not have to make appointments for your labs (because lab draw stations are all walk-in scheduling). You will need to get a baseline set of labs before you do your imaging or scans.

Your nurse will fill out which labs you need to do below:

We prefer you get your labs done at Michigan Medicine after your first new patient visit, before you leave the hospital. If this is not possible, please let our office know by calling (734) 936-5950 so we can make a different plan.

#### **EKG**

You can get your EKG at Michigan Medicine in the Frankel Cardiovascular Center (CVC) after your new patient appointment. We will give you a map to

show you where to go. You do not have to make an appointment (EKG at the
CVC is walk-in scheduling).
☐ My EKG has been ordered as part of my care, and I need to go to the CVC to have this done.
We prefer you get your EKG at Michigan Medicine after your first new patient
visit, before you leave the hospital. <b>EKG is located at the CVC, on Floor 3 at</b>
<b>Reception B (see map).</b> If this is not possible, please call our office by calling
(734) 936-5950 so we can make a different plan.
Imaging and scans
You can schedule all imaging and scanning you need by calling (734) 936-4500
Appointment times for these scans can fill up quickly, so please call to
schedule your scans as soon as possible. Locations for Michigan Medicine
imaging are listed later on in this handout. All scans are performed with
contrast unless your providers say otherwise.
Your nurse will highlight or circle the scans that you must complete below:
☐ CT neck
☐ CT sinus
☐ CT chest
☐ CT angiogram with runoff
☐ PET scan
☐ Any other scans:
We prefer that you do all your imaging through Michigan Medicine to have our
expert radiologists read the scans and to make sure your surgery is not

delayed.

- If you don't do your scans through Michigan Medicine, you must contact our office at (734) 936-5950 so we can help you arrange doing them elsewhere (sending orders, prior authorizations, etc.).
- If you do your scans outside Michigan Medicine, it is your responsibility to let us know the dates of your scans so we can request that they are sent to Michigan Medicine. Scans never get automatically sent.
- If you do scans outside of Michigan Medicine, we may still need our radiologist to read them. You may have to pay an extra cost for this.
- Having scans done outside of Michigan Medicine could possibly delay your oral surgery.

#### Clearances

Usually we will need different doctors you may see regularly to clear you for surgery (say it's okay and safe for you to have this surgery). This written permission from your doctor is called a **clearance**. Please read through the different types of clearances you will need below, and work through how you will get them with your nurse.

#### Pre-Op History and Physical (H&P)

Highlight or circle which way you will get this clearance from the 2 options below:

- My primary care provider (PCP) will complete this clearance.
   You will need to let us know who your PCP is, so that our office can fax our H&P form to your PCP's office.
- ☐ I will complete this clearance through the Michigan Medicine Pre-Op H&P clinic.
  - o You can schedule this appointment by calling (734) 936-3604.
  - The main clinic is located at 24 Frank Lloyd Wright Drive (Lobby C, Suite 1100), Ann Arbor, MI 48105. They also offer other

locations, or this can often be completed as a video visit. Call the phone number above for more details.

### Cardiology clearance

Your cardiologist will need to complete a cardiology clearance before you can get surgery. Our office must fax the cardiac clearance form to your cardiologist.

- ☐ I have provided the name of my cardiologist to the nurse during my new patient visit, so they can fax the form to my cardiologist.
  - If you haven't done this, please call our office at (734) 936-5950 to ask us to fax the form.

Note: If you are on any anticoagulant medications (blood thinners), you will need to review these with your cardiologist to see if you need to stop taking them before your surgery.

#### **Dental clearance**

Your dentist will need to complete a dental clearance to determine if you need to complete any other dental work before your surgery. Our office must fax the dental clearance form to your dentist's office.

- ☐ I have provided the name of my dentist to the nurse, so they can fax the form to my dentist.
  - If you haven't done this, please call our office at (734) 936-5950
     to ask us to fax the form.

#### Other clearances

If you have other clearances that you need to complete before surgery, your nurse will give you details below:

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# What else might I have to do before surgery?

If anything else is required for your surgery, our coordination nurse will reach out to you. Please make sure you have an active patient portal at <a href="MyUofMHealth.org">MyUofMHealth.org</a> and your phone number listed in your portal profile so we can get in contact with you.
