## When should I call my doctor?

If you think your wound is infected and needs to be seen immediately, go to the nearest emergency department. Signs and symptoms of infection.

- Redness or increased warmth around the wound.
- Temperature greater than 100.5 F.
- Increased drainage from the wound.
- Drainage smells foul.
