

What is Grafix?

Grafix is designed for application directly to acute and chronic wounds. An acute wound is recent and severe, a chronic wound is one that persists for a long time.

Grafix is made from human placenta that is preserved by cooling to below zero temperatures. Placenta skin is helpful for natural wound repair by serving as a protective layer against the environment and protecting the skin from further infection, reducing swelling, and reducing scarring.

Who can use Grafix?

- People with chronic wounds, such as diabetic foot wounds, venous wounds, and pressure ulcers.
- People with acute wounds such as surgical incisions, burns, and trauma.

Who cannot use Grafix?

- People who may have infected wounds.

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
