

How Do I Get a Breast Pump for Home?

If you are planning to feed your baby breast milk at home, it is recommended that you obtain a personal, electric breast pump.

How do I get my breast pump?

- At a prenatal provider's visit, when you are between 32 -34 weeks pregnant, ask your provider for a signed breast pump prescription.
- When you have the prescription, call your health insurance provider and ask if you have coverage to obtain a breast pump before the baby is delivered.
- If the answer is **yes**:
 - Ask your health insurance provider which durable medical equipment supplier you should call to order your pump.
 - Call the durable medical equipment supplier, give them the prescription information and order your breast pump.
- If the answer is no:
 - When you are in the hospital to have your baby, let your nurse know that you need to order a personal breast pump for home.
