Who do I contact with questions or concerns?

- For non-emergent questions or concerns after discharge, call the Clinic at (734) 936-5738. The clinic is open Monday-Friday 8:00-4:30.
- After business hours on weekends and holidays leave a message on voicemail
- If it can't wait until the next business day, call hospital paging at: (734) 936-6267 and ask for the Trauma Burn Resident on call.
- If it is an emergency, call 911.

Where is the clinic located?

We are located in **Taubman Center, 2nd Floor, Area C**. The Taubman Center is closest to the Visitor Parking Structure "P2".

What are the business hours?

- The clinic is open **Monday through Friday: 8:00 am – 4:30 pm**
- The clinic is closed weekends and holidays.
- Patients are seen by appointment Monday afternoons and Wednesday mornings.

What should I bring to my appointment?

- UM Blue registration card and insurance information.
- List of current medications, or bring bottles. (Prescription and over the counter medications and supplements)
- If you have a dressing or open wounds, we will perform a dressing change. If this will be painful for you, bring your pain medicine so you may pre-medicate yourself before the dressing change.
- A list of questions and concerns
- A list of needed items, including employer notes, prescription or supply refills.
