

Your provider has ordered some urine and blood work testing for you. You will collect your urine. Instructions on how to collect your urine for 24 hours will be provided by Litholink, the company who will be sending you a specimen container to collect your urine.

It is very important that you wait at least **2 months** after your last surgery or kidney stone passage before you do the urine collection and get blood testing.

Do these tests on a normal day when you are:

- Eating your typical diet
- Taking your usual medications
- Not having pain from a kidney stone or recovering from a surgery
