

More than just one building!

The Cardiovascular Center building is the new "front door" for adult heart and vascular care at the University of Michigan. But it's not the only place where CVC faculty and staff deliver superior, compassionate care; pursue innovative science and discovery; and foster excellence in education.

Here's a list of our other locations:

University Hospital: Home to many CVC diagnostic services including a Diagnostic Vascular Unit, and extensive medical imaging facilities including 64-slice CT, 3-Tesla MRI, nuclear cardiology, and a PET/CT scanner. The Clinical Pathology testing labs are also here.

CVC teams care for patients in the six-bed Stroke Unit on floor 4A, the 48-bed Cardiac Surgery Stepdown Telemetry Unit on floor 4BC, the 10-bed Cardiac Intensive Care Unit on floor 7D and the 64-bed Cardiology Stepdown Telemetry Unit on floor 7BC.

Patients needing emergency care for heart attacks, strokes and other acute cardiovascular situations will continue to go to the U-M Emergency Department, and may be flown to U-M by Survival Flight helicopters that land just outside University Hospital.

C.S. Mott Children's Hospital: The Michigan Congenital Heart Center, which is one of the world's leading centers for children's heart care and a crucial part of the CVC, is located here. It has its own outpatient diagnosis and treatment area, and its own operating and procedure rooms, intensive-care unit and inpatient rooms.

Domino's Farms: Located in northeastern Ann Arbor, this stunning facility is home to several adult cardiology outpatient clinics, diagnostic testing facilities, and a cardiovascular rehabilitation and prevention program that includes a fitness center, nutrition counseling and stress-reduction classes. It's also home to the offices of the Michigan Cardiovascular Outcomes Research and Reporting Program.

U-M Health Centers: Our adult cardiologists see patients at the Briarwood Health Center in Ann Arbor, and at the U-M Health Centers in Livonia, Brighton, Canton and Chelsea. Our vascular specialists operate a Vein Center at the U-M Livonia Center for Specialty Care. Our cardiothoracic radiology teams perform CT scans at the Canton Health Center and the East Ann Arbor Health & Geriatrics Center.

VA Ann Arbor Healthcare Center: Some of our physicians treat veterans here, including surgery, procedures and outpatient clinics.

Research laboratories: CVC scientists and their teams perform advanced research at their labs in the Biomedical Science Research Building and the Medical Science Research Building complex.

Local hospitals: Our adult cardiac surgeons perform operations at Crittenton Hospital in Rochester, and beginning in 2008 they will operate at Foote Hospital in Jackson.
