A FLU SHOT IS RECOMMENDED IF YOU:

- are age 50 or older
- are age 6 months to 5 years (2 doses may be required)
- are a woman who will be pregnant during flu season
- work or live in a long-term care facility
- are a health care professional
- have a chronic health problem, such as asthma, heart disease, emphysema or diabetes
- live in a household with or provide care to, someone who has a medical condition that puts them at high risk for severe complications from the flu (such as a chronic health problem or HIV)
- want to reduce the risk of becoming ill with flu or transmitting flu to others this year
- live in a household with, or provide care to, a child less than 5 years old or an adult 50 or older

YOU CANNOT RECEIVE A FLU SHOT IF YOU:

- are under 6 months old
- have a fever of 101 or more
- have an allergy to eggs/eggs products
- have a Thimerosal allergy
- have been diagnosed with Guillian-Barre Syndrome
- are allergic to Benadryl or Epinephrine
