The following insurances will be accepted: Medicare Part B, any Medicare Advantage Plan, BCN, HAP (No CIGNA HAP) and Priority Health. Participants must show insurance card at the time of vaccination. The flu vaccine is \$42 if not covered by an accepted insurance. Payment options include cash, check and credit card. Pneumovax will not be available at this time. The H1N1 flu vaccine will not be available at this time, and it is not currently recommended by the Centers for Disease Control for seniors. The flu vaccine is \$33, if not covered by an accepted insurance. Payment options include cash, check and credit card. Pneumovax will be available. The H1N1 flu vaccine will not be available at this time, and it is not currently recommended by the Centers for Disease Control for seniors.
