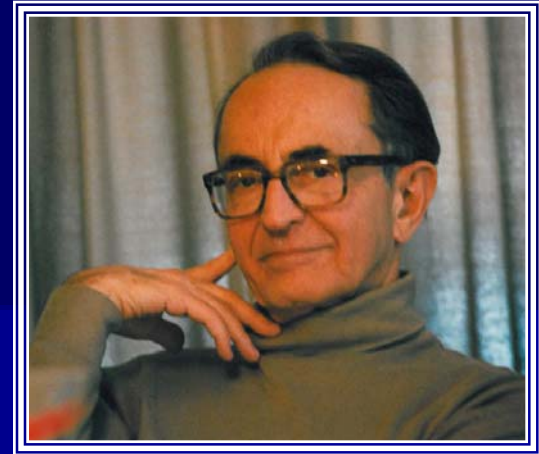

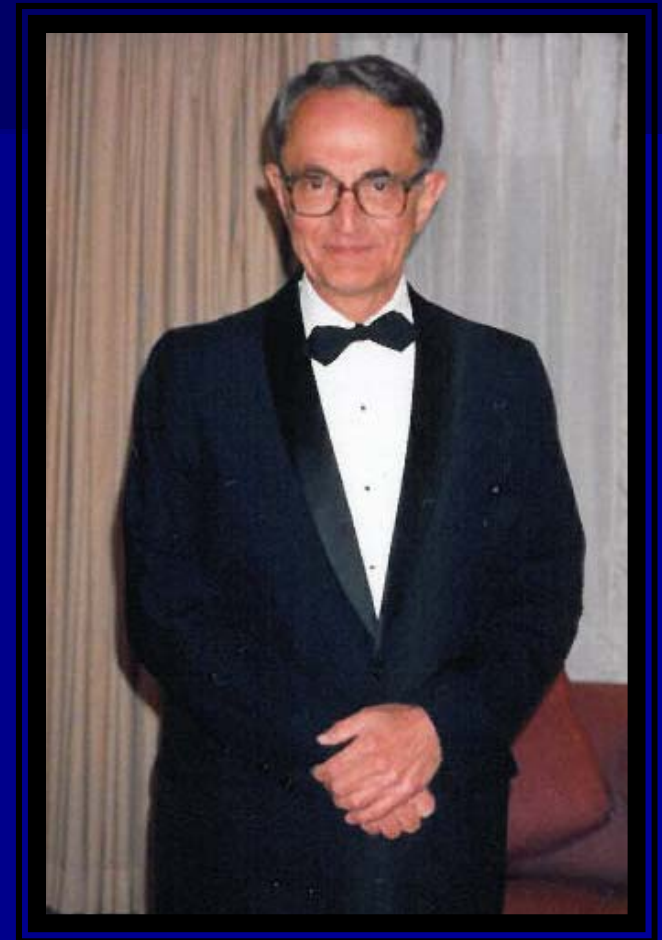

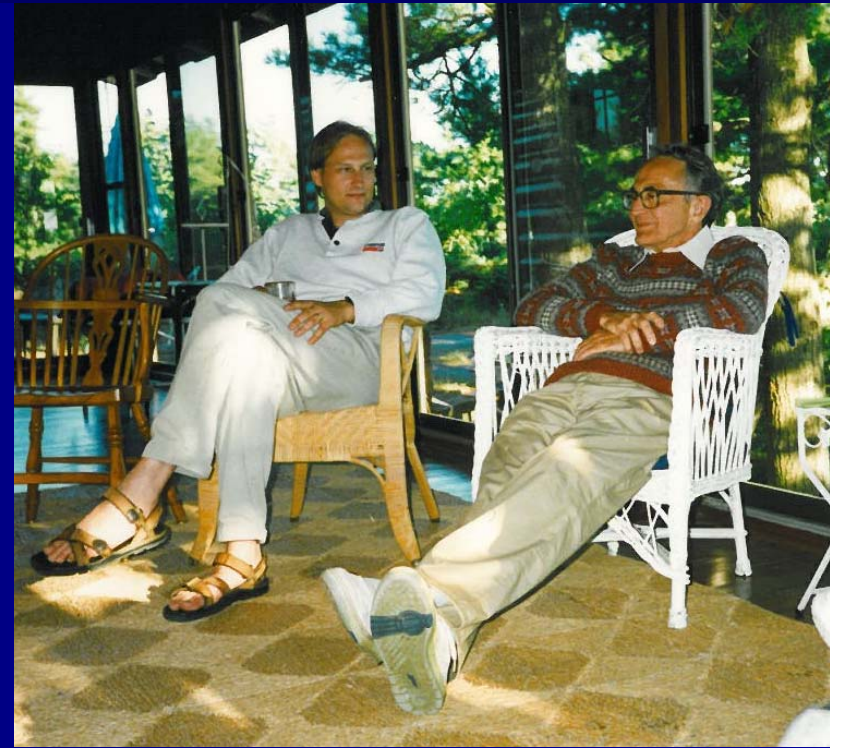


A Human Research Protection Program (HRPP) at UMHS: William W. Coon
