During present epidemic of influenza great care will be taken in training of men intensified work will not be required where there is any danger of epidemic spreading training instructions will be continued but in a lightened form every effort will be made to carry on instruction in open air but must not involve undue crowding of men or any overexertion notify all aviation flying schools also all others under your control.
