## Parking

Paid parking permits or AVI devices are required to park in University lots and structures. There are a variety of types of lots/structures with parking permits depending upon the proximity of the lots to the University. (See map for parking locations.) Designated areas for people with disabilities are provided in all staff parking areas. To use these spaces, display of the appropriate University Parking permit or AVI device, along with a state disabled permit plate, is required. Information on obtaining a parking permit is available through Parking Services. The Parking and Customer Services office is not located at 777 North University, which is across Thayer from Hill Auditorium at the northwest corner of the diag. The office hours are 7:30am-4:30pm, Monday through Friday. They are closed on Tuesdays from 11:30am-1:00pm.
