### **Course Description:**

During the Peds Hem/Onc (PHO) elective, the student will have the opportunity to participate in the outpatient care of children with cancer and hematologic problems. The elective compliments the intensive inpatient PHO experience and allows the student to recognize that many patients who are acutely ill at the time of diagnosis recover from their morbidities and resume normal activities of childhood and adolescence, even while continuing to receive therapy. The Student will have the opportunity to see a large number of oncology patients who have completed their treatment regimens and who are followed to monitor disease recurrence.
