### **Course Description:**

Students will learn advanced assessment skills of geriatric psychiatry patients in both inpatient and outpatient settings as part of a treatment team. A focus on the 3 D's of geriatric psychiatry – Dementia, Depression, and Delirium will occur. Advanced strategies in bedside neurocognitive testing will be presented. Learners will develop familiarity with geriatric community resources and family interventions. Sites include the University Hospital for inpatient, the Geriatric Center for outpatient, and the VA for inpatient and outpatient services.
