

Grading Policy M3 Required Rotation

Family Medicine

Grade Based on:

60% Clinical Evaluations
20% Exam - NBME
20% Exam - Family Case Study Paper

Distribution for Final Grade:

15 to 20% Honors
50 to 60% High Pass
20 to 35% Pass

To receive a passing grade:

1. Students must pass the clinical component to pass
2. Superior performance in one category does not compensate for deficiency in another category.

Clerkship Requirements:

Graded

1. NBME Subject Exam
2. Family Case Study Paper

Pass/Fail

1. Case Discussions
2. CLTP Documentation of at least 60 patient encounters
3. Community Agency Visit/Presentation
4. Direct Observation Experience
5. Attendance at Clerkship Classroom Sessions

Policy on Exam Failure:

1. If student performance on the shelf exam is more than two standard deviations below the mean for his/her cohort the student will receive a grade of Fail for the shelf exam.

If the student passes the other two clerkship components the student will not have to remediate the shelf exam.

2. If a student fails the clinical component of the clerkship the student will be assigned an overall grade of Fail and must repeat the rotation, including taking the shelf exam.
