

Grading Policy M3 Required Rotation

Internal Medicine

Grade Based on:

75% Clinical Evaluations
25% Exams

Distribution for Final Grade:

15% Honors
35% High Pass
50% Pass

To receive a passing grade:

1. Students must pass the clinical phase (academically and professionally)
2. Must pass all exams.
3. Superior performance in one category does not compensate for deficiency in another category.

Clerkship Test Requirements:

1. NBME Subject Exam
2. Diagnostic Pattern Recognition Exam
3. CXR Exam
4. EKG Exam
5. Cardio Vascular Exam
6. Smoking Cessation SPI

Policy on Exam Failure:

1. If overall clinical performance is good or better and the student fails one or more exams the student will receive an I/E and may repeat the exam. For acad year 2003-04, this is defined as an average clinical score of 5.5 or better, using standard formula.
2. If a student's overall clinical performance is weak (defined as below 5.5, see above) and he/she fails an exam, the student will be assigned a fail and be required to remediate the rotation.
