

2007-2008 PARKING OPTIONS MEDICAL STUDENTS

THE RATES LISTED BELOW ARE FOR THE 2007-2008 PERMIT YEAR (JULY 1, 2007-JUNE 30, 2008).

Parking for students at the University of Michigan is very limited. Therefore, we encourage students to leave their vehicles at home or off-site and use the transit services that are available for moving about campus and the Ann Arbor community. The information listed below explains the various transit and parking options that are available to Medical Students.

Please note: The information provided is correct at the time of printing; however, programs are subject to change and may be revised throughout the permit year. Whenever possible, please call (764-8291) or e-mail (umpark@umich.edu) for the most up-to-date information.

AATA MRIDE...

FREE ANN ARBOR TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY (AATA) BUS SERVICE

All active University of Michigan-Ann Arbor students are able to ride AATA fixed-route bus service without paying a fare at any time of day, any day of the week. U-M passengers need only to show a valid Mcard ID (yellow card) to access AATA's MRide Program.

FREE PARKING...

AATA PARK & RIDE – UM Parking and Transportation Services and the Ann Arbor Transportation Authority (AATA) offer five (5) off-site parking locations free of charge; no permit required. In order to ride the AATA bus free of charge, simply present your UM Student Identification card to the bus driver.

PAID PARKING...

All permits are valid July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008. The cost and value of the permit prorates down on an established schedule the first and 15th of each month.

STUDENT ORANGE PERMIT – Approximately two thousand (2,000) parking permits will be available. Permits are valid for daily parking only and may **not** be used for "storage" parking. Permits are honored at any Orange lots on north or south campus. The permit is **not** honored in Lot M75 located on medical campus by the Fuller/Mitchell fields. Orange lots are typically located on the perimeter of campus and are serviced by University or AATA buses. **ANNUAL PARKING FEE: \$67** (available at Parking Services)

STUDENT YELLOW PERMIT – Permit is valid for daily parking only and may **not** be used for "storage" parking. Permits are honored at any Yellow lot on north or south campus, except for Lot NC40 located on North Campus near the Stearns building. The permit is also honored in any Orange lot on north or south campus. The permit is not honored at the Yellow lots on medical campus (Fuller Pool, Lot M71 or Lot M76). **ANNUAL PARKING FEE: \$135** (available at Parking Services)

AFTER HOURS STUDENT PERMIT – The permit is valid in any Blue parking area after 3 pm to 5 am, Monday through Friday, and all day on the weekends. **ANNUAL PARKING FEE: \$52** (available at Parking Services)

STUDENT ORANGE/AFTER HOURS PERMIT - The Student Orange/After Hour permit is a dual permit combining two student parking options: Student Orange and After Hour. **ANNUAL PARKING FEE: \$119** (available at Parking Services)

STUDENT YELLOW/AFTER HOURS PERMIT - The Student Yellow/After Hour permit is a dual permit combining two student parking options: Student Yellow and After Hour. **ANNUAL PARKING FEE: \$187** (available at Parking Services)

SILVER FULLER POOL PERMIT -- The University expects to lease the Fuller Pool parking lot again from September 4, 2007 through May 23, 2008. If this occurs as expected, 50 Silver Fuller Pool permits will be available. The permit will only be honored at the Fuller Pool parking lot. The Office of Student Programs will handle distribution of the permit to Medical Students in late August or early September. **ANNUAL PARKING FEE: \$101.16.**

MONTHLY BLUE PERMITS – A limited number of monthly Blue parking permits are available **ONLY** to fourth year students assigned at **University Hospital** to a **sub-internship or emergency medicine**; and third year students assigned to **inpatient medicine; general surgery; Ob/Gyn, or inpatient pediatrics at University Hospital**. The permits are valid in any Blue parking area (with the exception of the Cancer Center Lot) for one month and go on sale the Wednesday prior to the start of a new clerkship. **Monthly Fee: \$59.75; Six Week Fee: \$89.62.**

These permits may be purchased with cash/check at the front desk in the Office of Student Programs, C5124 Medical Science I, 764-0219, from 8:00 am - 5:00 pm, Monday through Friday. They are available for purchase beginning at 8:00 am the Wednesday before rotation starts and ending 5:00 pm Friday at the end of the first week of rotation. There are a limited number available on a first come, first serve basis. All sales are final; lost permits will not be replaced.

TAUBMAN PATIENT/VISITOR PARKING STRUCTURE – The University Hospitals and Health Centers structures -- Parking A (Taubman Center) and the lower level of Parking B (Cancer Center) -- are reserved for patients and visitors. Third and fourth year students **on off-site rotations** required to return to the University Hospital or the Medical School for lectures and seminars may park in the Parking A structure with the appropriate parking coupon obtained from the Office of Student Programs. When exiting the structure, the coupon must be presented to the cashier attendant to obtain the \$2 daily rate.
