**Guidelines for Senior Year for Students Interested in  
Pursuing a Career in Internal Medicine**

## **Subinternship:**

2 months of Internal Medicine is strongly recommended.  
You should include the ICU requirement as part of your SubI.

## **Electives:**

One to two months should be on the Internal Medicine Consult Service in the subspecialty of your choice, or an Ambulatory Care Month.

For Additional Courses:

- Take those courses that you are not likely to see again.
- Take courses outside of Medicine that interest you.
- Take an International Rotation elective
- Take courses that would compliment your career choice:  
    These would include, but are not limited to, Radiology, Dermatology, a Surgery Subspecialty, Psychiatry, Anesthesiology

## **Interviews:**

Most Internal Medicine programs interview from early November until the end of January, but there is considerable variability.

Most students should apply to between 12-20 schools, making sure they have interviews to at least 10 schools.
