\* Ipratropium bromide is not a recommended rescue inhaler outside of use in the emergency room or urgent care but may, on occasion, be prescribed to supplement short-acting Beta<sub>2</sub> agonists.

### Inhaled Corticosteroids (ICS): Metered-Dose Inhalers (MDI)




