

# Research Opportunity: Testing the Learning Skills of Your Child with CP



The University of Michigan Health System and Mary Free Bed Rehabilitation Hospital are conducting research on new ways to test the learning skills of children with cerebral palsy. Children who take part in the study will be able to try computerized tests of learning while parents watch. To take part in the study, children must:

- Be 8-16 years of age
- Have a previous documented medical diagnosis of Cerebral Palsy,
- Have the ability to consistently communicate a choice when presented with different options,
- Have their parent (or legal guardian) provide written, informed approval to participate,
- Have no medical or psychiatric condition that affects the tests, no history of brain injury unrelated to the diagnosis of Cerebral Palsy, and no recent major changes in medication.

Participants can expect to spend about 2 – 2½ hours in the study, and will be paid a **\$50.00** honorarium for their time and effort.
