PLEASE:

Purchase or make valentine cards appropriate for adult patients that would fit into a bag (lunch bag size). With respect to all of our patients and diagnoses, we ask that religious references not be made or that the cards not say "Get well soon!" For safety reasons we also request that glitter not be used or food attached to cards. Please do not place cards in envelopes.

Sign cards with a first name or name of an organization or just say "Happy Valentine's Day!"
