PURPOSE:

In order to provide pediatric and adult inpatients and outpatients with an envelope filled with cards and activities for Valentine's Day; we are asking for assistance from youth, adults, employees, schools, churches, and community organizations.

PLEASE:

- Make or purchase non-violent valentine cards that would be appropriate for pediatric and adult patients no larger than 6" x 9". With respect to all of our patients and diagnoses, we ask that religious references not be made or that the cards not say "Get well soon!" For safety reasons we also request that glitter not be used nor food or other items be attached to cards.
- Omit envelopes since all cards will need to be scanned.
- Sign cards with a first name or name of an organization or just say "Happy Valentine's Day!" Cards may be addressed "To: A Special Friend" or left plain.
- Consider additional projects for patients including laminated valentine place mats, tray favors containing commercially made and individually wrapped candy, valentine pencils, or valentine stickers. This year we won't be collecting decorated shoeboxes due to space limitations.
