Breast Imaging Scheduling Questions - UMHS Radiology

These questions are asked by Radiology Call Center staff when someone calls to schedule a Breast Imaging exam. They help us determine where/when to best schedule the exam, and prepare for the examination. We hope that you are better prepared when you call, so that we can expedite your call.

- 1. Are you (the patient) having any current problems or known diagnostic indications, including: a palpable mass, thickness, dimpling, nodularity, skin changes, retracted nipple, discharge, C/B, follow up of an abnormal mammogram, UNK, primary, persistent pain, fibrocystic disease, ovarian cancer or implant complications?**
 - If yes, which breast? For documentation and exam set up
- 2. When did you (the patient) have your last mammogram?** Please have the date or approximated date ready for documentation when you call
- 3. Do you have any special needs (ex: wheelchair, oxygen, prisoner, group home)?** Please let us know so we can document them and make sure any necessary accommodations are made.
