

NOTIFICATION OF PRACTITIONER RIGHTS

- Upon written request, the applicant has the right to review the information obtained to evaluate credentials during the credentialing or recredentialing process.
- The practitioner will be notified if there is a substantial variation in information regarding actions on licensure, malpractice claims history and board certification.
- The practitioner may not review references or recommendations or other information that is deemed peer review protected.
- The applicant has the right to correct erroneous information from other sources. In the
 event the credentialing information obtained from other sources varies substantially
 from that provided by the applicant, the applicant will be notified of discrepancy and
 the process to correct the erroneous information submitted by another party.
- Thirty (30) days will be allowed for erroneous information to be corrected.
- The applicant has the right to be informed of the status of his or her credentialing or recredentialing application upon request.
