

Medical Innovation Center Design and Prototype Lab

The MIC Design and Prototyping Lab is available to help medical device innovators advance their product ideas.



Located at 300 North Ingalls, the Lab is a fully equipped machine shop that also includes rapid prototyping equipment, several of which were made possible by a generous grant from the Michigan Institute for Clinical and Health Research (MICHHR).

The Lab operates on a “**fee for service**” basis-- materials expenses plus labor rates of between \$100 and \$150 per hour. The Lab operations are managed by **Toby Donajkowski** who draws on over 20 years of medical instrument and device design and manufacture.
