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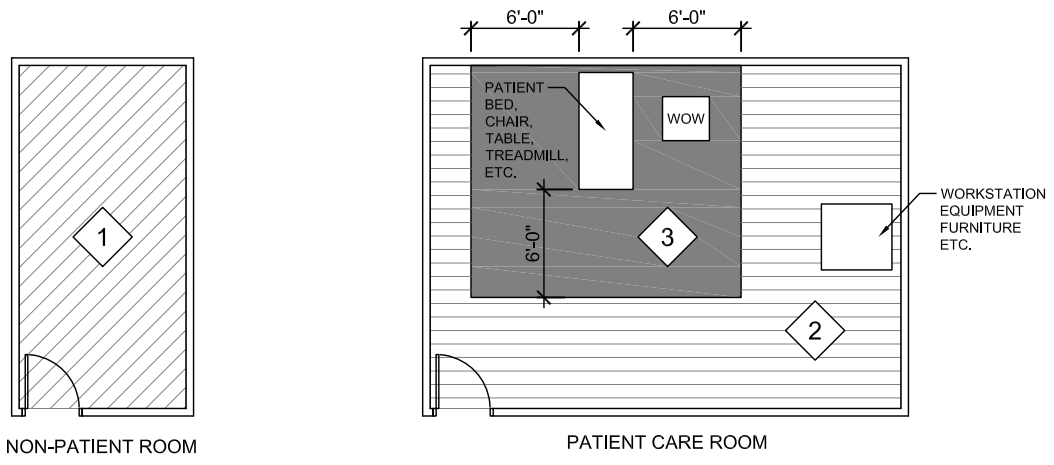


THERE ARE THREE TYPES OF POWER STRIPS USED AT MICHIGAN MEDICINE:

- 1 POWER STRIPS LISTED TO U.L.**
- CAN ONLY BE USED IN NON-PATIENT CARE ROOMS
 - CAN BE IDENTIFIED BY THE "U.L." LABEL ON THE STRIP
 - FREQUENTLY HAVE SWITCHES
 - CAN BE SET ON FLOORS, FURNITURE, ETC.
- 2 POWER STRIPS WITH HOSPITAL GRADE RECEPTACLES LISTED TO U.L. 1363**
- PERMITTED IN PATIENT ROOMS ONLY BEYOND THE 6'-0" PATIENT CARE VICINITY
 - ALSO APPLIES TO STAFF WORKSTATIONS IN OPEN-BAY PATIENT CARE AREAS
 - PERMITTED ONLY FOR NON-PATIENT CARE EQUIPMENT
 - CAN BE IDENTIFIED BY GREEN DOTS, "U.L. 1363" LABEL AND NO SWITCH
 - MAY NOT BE SET ON FLOORS
 - MUST BE SCREWED TO CARTS, EQUIPMENT OR FURNITURE (NOT ZIP-TIED, TAPED OR STRAPPED)



- 3 SPECIAL PURPOSE RELOCATABLE POWER TAPS ("SPRPT") LISTED TO U.L. 1363A**
- ONLY POWER STRIPS PERMITTED WITHIN THE 6'-0" PATIENT CARE VICINITY
 - APPLIES TO INPATIENT OR OUTPATIENT SITUATIONS
 - SPRPT ARE FOR PATIENT CARE EQUIPMENT ONLY, INCLUDING WORKSTATIONS ON WHEELS ("WOWS")
 - SPRPT MUST BE SCREWED TO CART, EQUIPMENT OR FURNITURE (NOT ZIP-TIED, TAPED OR STRAPPED)
 - INDIVIDUAL PLUGS MAY OR MAY NOT BE SECURED WITH SELF-LOCKING COVERS DEPENDING ON MANUFACTURER
 - THESE CAN BE IDENTIFIED BY GREEN DOTS, THE "U.L. 60601-1" OR "U.L. 1363A" LABEL AND NO SWITCH



- NOTE:** ALL FLEXIBLE CORDS AND CABLES SHALL BE USED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE (NEC) NFPA-70/400.8 IN EFFECT
- EXTENSION CORDS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO EXTEND THE REACH OF POWER STRIP CORDS
 - POWER STRIP CORDS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO RUN THROUGH HOLES IN WALLS, CEILINGS, FLOORS, DOORWAYS, WINDOWS OR SIMILAR OPENINGS
 - POWER STRIPS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO BE ATTACHED TO BUILDING SURFACES SUCH AS WALLS, FLOORS, CEILINGS, ETC.
 - POWER STRIPS AND CORDS SHALL NOT BE INSTALLED WHERE SUBJECT TO PHYSICAL DAMAGE
