



INSURANCE INFORMATION FOR PRENATAL SCREENING

FIRST TRIMESTER SCREEN

If you are considering the First Trimester Screen, this blood work can be done as early as 9 weeks gestation and the ultrasound is best done at 12 weeks gestation. For information about coverage, please contact your insurance company. You may need the following CPT codes:

- For ultrasound, nuchal lucency: 76801 and 76813
- For blood work: 84163, 84702 and 82105

CELL FREE DNA

If you are considering cfDNA, this blood work can be performed starting at 10 weeks gestation. The lab currently used by University of Michigan Health in most cases is Natera. Natera's cfDNA test is called Panorama. If you have questions about cost, please know that most patients do not pay over \$200 once their deductible is met. Natera will automatically contact a patient via text message or email if their out-of-pocket expenses are going to be over \$249. At that point, you will have the option of paying the higher amount – which would go towards your deductible – or paying Natera a discounted cash option of \$249. In other words, the maximum amount you will pay for cfDNA testing is \$249.
