Healthy Choices & Safety

Goals and Values

- Before making decisions about drinking alcohol, using cannabis, or taking other drugs: pause and ask yourself, how does this fit in with my goals and what's important to my future?
- Practice ways to turn down offers: "No thanks," "I don't drink," or "I'm not interested"
- Hang out with friends who don't drink or use cannabis or drugs
- Plan ahead: leave a party early or find something else fun to do

Safety Strategies

- Avoid drinking and driving and driving after using cannabis or drugs. Plan a safe way home ahead of time
- Call 911 if someone is unresponsive or passed out after drinking alcohol, mixing substances, or using cannabis or other drugs
- Using alcohol, cannabis, or other drugs during pregnancy can cause health harms and complications

Signs of Problems

- Getting drunk or using cannabis regularly
- Misusing prescriptions or using illegal drugs
- Feeling depressed or anxious, or having thoughts of suicide
- Having blackouts or forgetting what you did while drinking or using substances
- Having problems at school or with the law
- Giving up activities and avoiding your friends who don't drink or use substances
- Ask for help, there are programs and people who care (see resources)
