



BEFORE ENTERING ROOM PREPARATION

- Appropriate Hand Hygiene
- Don PPE with an Observer

MONITORS

- BP Cuff on and cycling every 2 minutes
- Pulse oximeter positioned and corresponding volume on
- EKG monitoring
- If arterial line existing ensure tracing connected to monitor

ACCESS & MEDICATIONS

- IV or central access connected to IVFs and push line readily accessible
- 10 mL flush syringe x 3 available
- Verify infusions appropriately connected and running
- Have vasopressor and sedation infusions ready
- Controlled substances (fentanyl and midazolam) to be readily accessible

POSITIONING

- Bed pushed 3 feet away from wall
- Remove headboard
- Patient's head at the top edge of bed
- 2 blankets underneath shoulders, pillow underneath head

EQUIPMENT

- Ambu bag with HME filter between bag and facemask (flow not turned on)
- Yanker suction available and on near the head of the bed
- 10 mL syringe available
- End tidal CO₂ available
- Trash near head of bed
- Disinfecting wipes readily available in patient room

- Introductions
- Delineation of roles
- Verification of patient and procedure
- Discussion of airway management plan
